

Outdoor Oil Lamp

WARNING OUTDOOR USE ONLY
KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES

In the case of small children, just a small sip of lamp oil or even sucking the wick may lead to life threatening lung damage.

If lamp oil is swallowed, DO NOT induce vomiting. Seek medical advice immediately or contact a poison information centre.

Safety Information

- Only use lamp or citronella oil
- Never use petrol, kerosene or other flammable fuels
- Do not fill from containers that have previously held petroleum
- Keep children and pets away from the naked flame
- Never leave unattended when burning
- Never use this product if any of its parts are missing/damaged
- Keep the oil container in holder facing up when stored

Instructions for use-filling lamp

- Do not fill near naked flame
- Remove wick holder by pushing and turning the wick holder anti clockwise to reveal the filler opening
- Fill the container using a funnel or easy fill bottle, up to 70% capacity
- Be careful not to spill any oil. If spilt, wipe clean before use
- Make sure no water gets into the container
- Position the wick so it is 10mm above the holder
- If wick becomes detached from the holder, the wick may fray. If this occurs use clear tape to tighten and re-install
- Turn clockwise to screw the holder into place
- Insure the fuel container is securely back in lamp holder
- Now ready for use

Lighting the torch

- Allow 10-15 minutes for the wick to saturate the oil before lighting
- Use a long match or taper to light
- If lamp burns with excessive flame/smoke, extinguish the lamp, allow to cool and adjust wick length

Burning behaviour

- If on the first burn leakage of fuel appears from the holder, extinguish the flame, when cooled check the oil level is correct, adjust wick and re-light

Extinguishing the lamp

- Place the candle snuffer, or other fire resistant object completely over the flame until flame is completely out
- Do not touch snuffer cap until it has had time to completely cool down
- Do not move the lamp until fully cooled down

Care and maintenance

- If there are signs of leakage, cracks or corrosion do not try to repair the oil container
- Replacement containers can be purchased through your local re-seller
- Keep the wick and oil container clean and free of foreign objects
- Wick is supplied with the oil burner
