

Rattan Products

Our products are hand-woven and the base material is a rapidly growing rattan species from Indonesia. Rattan replenishes itself after being cut. The contemporary, rustic look of our collection is created by a special procedure involving soaking and drying of the material. Soaking the rattan in the mud for a couple of days, leads in the exquisite grey color. The collection includes baskets with and without plastic lining to hold potted plants, storage and laundry baskets and conservatory furniture. Rattan's versatility makes it ideal for today's look. Rattan is as beautiful as it is durable, so most rattan furniture needs only basic cleaning and care to preserve its natural strength and color.

Keeping your rattan furniture looking as beautiful as the day you bought it, cleaning the surface regularly is necessary. A monthly or even weekly cleaning is the best way to protect your rattan furniture and prevent damage. Clean the rattan with water. Keep the furniture indoors. While rattan certainly likes humidity, it is not outdoor furniture. Do a major cleaning once a year. A thorough cleaning will take care of dirt buildup and will also prevent further damage. Scrub the rattan with detergent, using slightly more water than you use for the weekly cleaning. Finally, apply a coat of shellac or lacquer to seal the rattan until the next year's cleaning.
